TPDES CONSTRUCTION SITE NOTICE

PART I: GENERAL

1.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- A. Documentation to be prepared and signed by the Contractor before conducting construction operations, in accordance with the Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination system (TPDES) Construction General Permit Number TXR-150000 issued March 5, 2003 (the Construction General Permit).

3.1 CONSTRUCTION SITE NOTICE FOR SMALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

- A. Fill out, sign, and date the Construction Site Notice, Section 01412, TPDES General Permit TXR 150000 "Construction Site Notice".
- B. Transmit the signed Construction Site Notice to the Project Manager at least seven days (7 D) prior to Commencement of Construction Activity.
