Priscilla and Lance Menchaca, Co-Owners



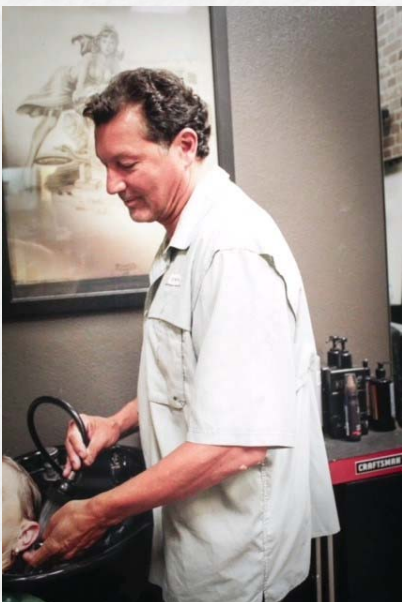
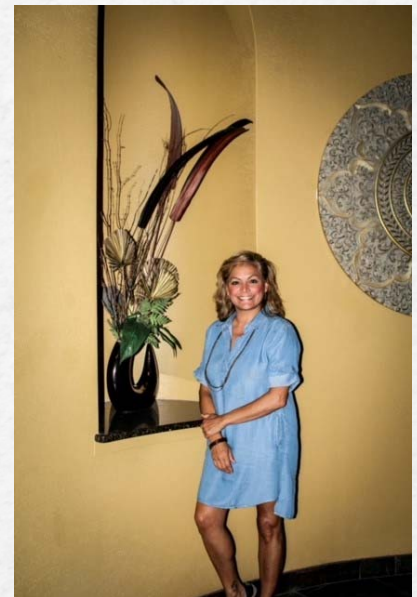
